GCAC Tournament kicks with games at SUNO

New Orleans, LA - [Southern University at New Orleans \(SUNO\)](http://www.suno.edu) will host the first rounds of both the women's and men's [Gulf Coast Athletic Conference Tournament](#) tonight and tomorrow night. **Both games will tip off at 7 p.m. in The Castle at 6400 Press Dr.**

The 7th seeded **SUNO Lady Knights** (13-11, 7-11) will host the 10th seeded Spring Hill Lady Badgers (3-25, 1-17) tonight (Monday). SUNO swept Spring Hill in the regular season with a 76-57 win on January 9th and a 69-62 victory on February 8th.

SUNO is led by 2008-2009 All-Conference selection and 2009-2010 pre-season All-Conference selection Jazzlyn Prince, who is a senior guard. Prince averages 10.79 points per game and 5.67 rebounds per game. She leads the Lady Knights with 3.75 assists and 3.21 steals per game. Prince ranks 4th in steals, 13th in steals and 40th and 40th in assists in the NAIA.

The Lady Knights' top 25 national rankings are the following: 17th 3-point field goal defense percentage (28), 19th in steals per game (11.667), 21st in scoring defense per game (59.917), 22nd in blocks per game (3.542) and 22nd in field goal percentage defense per game (37.2).

The winner will go to Shreveport to face LSU-Shreveport on Wednesday night.

The 8th seeded **Knights** (12-14, 7-11) will host the 9th seeded Loyola Wolfpack (13-16, 5-13) tomorrow night (Tuesday). SUNO split the season series with Loyola with an 88-74 loss on January 14th in The Den and an 88-70 February 4th win in The Castle. The Knights have won six of their last nine games, including a 79-76 upset over LSU-Shreveport, who is ranked 8th in the NAIA.

SUNO is led by senior guard Lionel Green, who is a pre-season All-GCAC selection. Green, who prepped at George Washington Carver High School, leads SUNO with 18.82 points and 4.7 assists per game. He also has 6.33 rebounds per game. Green ranks 16th in average assists, 18th in scoring average, 22nd in total assists (127) and 26th in total scoring (508) in the NAIA.

The Knights rank 11th in 3-point field goal defense percentage (30.3), 12th in 3-point percentage (37.7) and 25th in offensive rebounds per game (13.077) in the NAIA. These are the top 25 rankings.

The winner of the first round will travel to Shreveport to take on the LSU-Shreveport Pilots on Thursday.
